Beginning with the 1989-1990 League year, nineteen Junior League of Buffalo members have been recognized for their extraordinary work in the Western New York community and awarded the *Susan Reid Greene Russell Award*. Named in honor of a past Junior League of Buffalo president (1972-1973) and past Association of Junior Leagues (AJL) president (1976-1978), the award honors the recipient's lifetime commitment to voluntarism in both League and in the Western New York community.

The only way to recognize the significant accomplishments of past and current members is through **the NOMINATION process**. The committee encourages you to consider members who exemplify the missions of both the Junior League of Buffalo (JLB) and the Association of Junior Leagues International (AJLI).

The criteria for nomination and used during the selection process is as follows:

- She must be or has been a member of the Junior League of Buffalo.
- She has made a substantial contribution to the Junior League of Buffalo.
- She has fulfilled the mission and purpose of the Association of Junior Leagues International (AJLI) and the Junior League of Buffalo by impacting the community through her volunteer service.
- She has continued to maintain a connection with the Junior League of Buffalo.

A list of all previous recipients appears in the member handbook. Recipients may only be presented with this honor once in a lifetime.

The nomination form includes all the information you must provide. Please ensure that your nominee meets the criteria. The completed nomination package must be received by **Friday, March 26, 2010**.

Please chat with your fellow League members and review the membership directory for possible candidates. As we all know, there are many League members who could be potential recipients of the award. This is YOUR opportunity to nominate them and to salute their commitment to League and to the communities in which we live. The 21st recipient of the Susan Reid Greene Russell Award will be recognized at the Annual Dinner on Tuesday, May 25, 2010.
